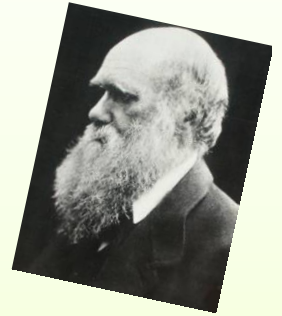




Darwin's Textile Challenge!
